#### LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR TAMMY MILLER

Tammy J. Miller was sworn in as the 39th lieutenant governor of North Dakota on Jan. 3, 2023. A native of Brocket, N.D., Miller graduated from high school in Lakota. She earned a bachelor's degree in accounting and a master of business administration degree from Minnesota State University Moorhead. Miller is a certified public accountant and early in her career spent eight years in public accounting.

Miller served as chief operating officer in the Governor's Office from April 2020 through December 2022, working with cabinet agencies to

enhance citizen focus, drive innovation and improve the delivery of government services. She previously served as CEO of Fargo-based Border States, the sixth-largest electrical distributor in North America. Under Miller's leadership, Border States grew from under \$500 million in annual sales to nearly \$2.5 billion.

As lieutenant governor, Miller serves as president of the state Senate and chairs the Capitol Grounds Planning Commission, North Dakota Trade Office, Task Force for Military Issues in North Dakota, Northern Plains Unmanned Systems Authority, State Investment Board, State Board of Equalization and Early Childhood Council.

### DR. ANDREA TRAVNICEK ND DEPT OF WATER RESOURCES

Dr. Andrea Travnicek was appointed by Governor Doug Burgum in August 2021 to oversee the North Dakota Department of Water Resources. In this role, Travnicek oversees the management of water resources for the state through water development, regulatory responsibilities, planning, education, and safety. Previously, Andrea was appointed by Governor Burgum in May 2020 to oversee the North Dakota Parks and Recreation Department.



Andrea has over 15 years of research and work experience within the natural resources, energy, agriculture, trade, national security, disaster response and recovery, communication, aviation, recreation, and public policy fields. Travnicek earned a bachelor's degree in natural resource management and zoology, a master's degree in natural resources management and a doctorate in philosophy, all from North Dakota State University. Travnicek is originally from Minot.



#### SENATOR KAREN K. KREBSBACH

Senator Karen Krebsbach is a member of the North Dakota State Senate from the 40th District, serving since 1988. Krebsbach is a member of the Republican party and, during the session, sits on the Appropriations Committee - Education and Environment Division, the Higher Education Grant Review Committee, and is Vice Chairman of Appropriations. In the interim, she serves on the Budget Section Committee, Higher Education Committee, and Retirement Committee.

Krebsbach has also served the Minot community in many capacities, including the Minot State University Board of Regents, Minot State University Foundation, Trinity Health Board, Norsk Høstfest Association, Magic City Discovery Center Board, and many more.

Krebsbach graduated with a bachelor of science degree in education from Minot State University in 1961.

#### REPRESENTATIVE EMILY O'BRIEN

Representative Emily O'Brien is a Republican member of the North Dakota House of Representatives from the 42nd District and has served since 2016.

O'Brien is a native of Lakeville, MN, and a graduate of the University of North Dakota in Entrepreneurship and Business Management.

She currently serves on the Industry Business and Labor and Transportation Committees during the regular session. In the interim, she serves on the Acute Psychiatric Treatment Committee and serves as the Vice-Chair for the Legislative Audit and Fiscal Review Committee.



In 2020, Emily was appointed to the North Dakota Lottery Advisory Commission and most recently, appointed to the National Conference of Insurance Legislators Committee.

Professionally, O'Brien serves as the Chief Operating Officer for the Bioscience Association of North Dakota. O'Brien has led growing teams both in the private sector and as an active board member for several non-profit organizations.



#### **COMMISSIONER JULIE FEDORCHAK**

Julie Fedorchak has served on the Commission since 2012. She heads the pipeline, electric transmission and energy conversion siting; railroad safety and regulation; MISO/OMS; and economic regulation-gas portfolios. A North Dakota native, Julie was appointed to the Public Service Commission in December 2012 by Gov. Jack Dalrymple. She was confirmed by voters in 2014 and was elected to a full six-year term in 2016 and again in 2022.

Julie's overarching priority is to make government more responsive to North Dakota citizens. With her leadership, North Dakota became


the first state to mitigate the light pollution caused by continuous red blinking lights on wind generators spanning the state's open landscape.


